WATER QUALITY STANDARDS

President Barack Obama, President of the United States of America (herein after referred to as “President Barack Obama”), having an address of The White House, 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue NW, Washington D.C., 20500, in accordance with the authority vested in him under the United States Constitution and pursuant to the United States Codes; and in witness of Secretary Hillary Rodham Clinton, United States Secretary of State, having an address of U.S. Department of State, 2201 C Street NW, Washington, DC 20520; and additionally in witness of Attorney General Eric Holder, Attorney General of the United States of America, having an address of U.S. Department of Justice, 950 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, Washington, DC 20530-0001; and additionally in witness of Administrator Lisa P. Jackson, Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (“US EPA”), having an address of U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Ariel Rios Building, 1200 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, Washington, DC 20460, does hereby execute this Executive Order in interest of the Citizens of the United States of America, all States and Territories of the United States of America, to include each of such States and Territories’ political subdivisions, to adopt, promulgate and enforce the most strict Water Quality Standards (hereinafter “Standards”) as herein defined in the interest of the Citizens of the United States of America, i.e. public health and welfare, the preservation of our multi-media resources such as, but not limited to, State’s waters, public drinking water quality and aquatic life and for the mitigation of human origin toxic pollutant discharges and Greenhouse Gas emissions, and more specifically, attainment or maintenance of that water quality which shall assure protection of public water supplies, and the protection and
